The project involved a significant revitalization within Scarborough Town Centre. The work served to increase store capacity and was made up of various upgrades, including a relocation of the mall's food court, which involved a renovation of both the upper and lower levels of the centre.

The existing lower level retail spaces were carefully demolished to make room for a lower level food court. The upper level was then renovated to create new retail and restaurant spaces. The new food court has seating capacity for 900 individuals and encompasses twenty-one units, three restaurants, and four kiosks. To provide a more upscale dining atmosphere and experience, new restaurants with higher quality food were introduced. The revitalized spaces are now enhanced with more natural light, open spacing, and modern furniture.
